
Annual Report 2014-2015


➤ **Awareness Programmes**

On the second day (26.10.2016) Shri L.M.V. Devakumar, Senior Manager (Retd) Canara Bank, Vellore has delivered the talk on "Emotional Management". He listed the causes for stress among different age group and way in which the stress could be removed to have the free happy life at house, working place and in the society. He talked more on time management.

As overwhelming programme, the fire prevention and fighting methods were demonstrated by the District Fire Officers from SIPCOT, Ranipet. The team has advised volunteers to celebrate the forthcoming Diwali as "Safe" Diwali. If fire occurs how to make rescue operations? Was the main focus of this demonstration. The YRC volunteers and programme officers largely participated in the demonstration which was conducted at the university Campus.

In the afternoon, Mr. S. N. Janarthnan, Secretary, Indian Red Cross Society, Katpadi Sub-branch and Mr. T. V. 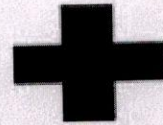
