Convergence and Divergence of Culture is the wider concept of Literature and later it changed its facet as Cultural Literature. Culture is the blend of various cultures belonging to diverse religion, castes; regions follow their own tradition and culture. It is the co-existence of the cultural diversity to policies in which the people of various ethnic and religious groups are addressed by the authorities.
