This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) entered into on the 05.08.2015

#### BETWEEN

Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamilnadu, India, represented by the Prof. Dr. S. THAMARAI SELVI, Vice- Chancellor with its headquarters at Vellore, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the ONE PART

#### AND

The Tamil University, Tanjure, Tamilnadu, India represented by Prof. Dr. Balasubramanian, Vice-Chancellor, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the OTHER PART

Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India, and Tamil University, Tanjure, will henceforth be referred to as the 'Parties'. Accordingly, the Parties have decided to enter into this MOU for the aforesaid objectives on the terms & conditions as mentioned hereunder.

### ARTICLE 1 - OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE

The objective of this MoU is to set out the framework within which Tamil University, Tanjure and Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India, will jointly explore and work towards promoting excellence of economic students' knowledge in their subjects as described in the MoU. Each party shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to determine how it will fulfil its obligations hereunder.

If Tamil University, Tanjure and Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India, mutually agree to pursue any of objectives and undertakings herein, the terms and conditions for pursuing such objectives shall be documented on a case-to-case basis under project documents to be negotiated and finalized between the parties. The projects may relate to the following subjects:

Students exchange and Knowledge sharing about Siddha and traditional medicinal plants between TVU and TU.

Providing proper manuscript training for students and faculty members.

Exchange the literary work between TVU and TU

Cooperation between TVU and TU in book publication related matters.

Training programmes, conducting workshop, seminars and symposium on inscriptions, sculpture, classical Music, folk arts and related fields of Tamii studies

# ARTICLE 2 - ADMINISTRATION OF MOU

To achieve the objective of the Tamil university, Tanjure and Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India. shall set up a Joint Coordination Committee. The JCC may invite any expert to assist its work, if needed

#### ARTICLE 3 - CONFIDENTIALITY

Both parties agree that information obtained in carrying out the objectives shall be kept confidential, unless decided otherwise with mutual agreement.

# 1. DISCLOSURE, USE AND RESTRICTIONS:

1.1 The Receiving Party shall use the Confidential Information solely in connection with the Purpose identified hereinabove to explore a potential business relationship between the Parties.

# 1.2 The Receiving Party agrees:

- (a.) to maintain in confidence all Confidential Information of the Disclosing Party and not use such Confidential Information other than as necessary to carry out the Purpose;
- (b.) not to disclose any Confidential Information to any person except the Receiving Party's employees, directors, professional advisors and/or independent contractors who have a need to know for the above stated Purpose, and who are bound by obligations of confidentiality no less restrictive than the terms of this Agreement;
- (c.) to treat all Confidential Information of Discloser with the same degree of care that the Receiving Party accords its own Confidential Information, but in no case less than reasonable care;
- (d.) to prevent the unauthorized use, dissemination or publication of the Confidential Information;
- (e.) not to copy or reproduce any or all of the Confidential Information except as is reasonably necessary for the Purpose; and
- (f.) not to disclose to any person (other than permitted herein) the fact that Confidential Information has been made available, the contents and existence of this Agreement, that negotiations/discussions are taking place or any terms, conditions and status thereof.
- 1.3 The Receiving Party confirms that it has in place reasonable safeguards against the unauthorized disclosure of the Confidential Information such that it can comply with the provisions of this Agreement and agrees that, without prejudice to the foregoing, it shall protect the Confidential Information in at least the same manner and to at least the same degree that it protects its own confidential information, but shall in no event, employ less than reasonable degree of care. The Receiving Party further agrees to inform its employees having access to Confidential Information of the obligations hereunder.
- 1.4 The disclosure of Confidential Information by the Disclosing Party will not create an obligation on either Party to enter into any further agreement or to proceed with any possible relationship or other transaction.

#### ARTICLE 5 - VALIDITY

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for five years. This MOU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partner institutions

### ARTICLE 6 - DISPUTES

In case disputes arise in implementing the MoU, these shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation

#### ARTICLE 7 - TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this MOU with due notice 6 months and cannot be held liable, in anyway whatsoever, if the objectives cannot be achieved In the event of termination, any information gained from either party by way of technical processes, and procedures in any published or verbal format shall be bound by the confidentiality agreement.

# ARTICLE 8 - MISCELLANEOUS

Neither Party shall use or publicize the MoU in such a manner as to cause any disrepute to the other party and shall not make any statement relevant to this MoU which may reasonably be considered to be misleading.

#### ARTICLE 9 — TERM AND CONDITIONS

This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of institutes at any time.

Abdul Hakeem College, Melvisharam represented by its Principal Dr.Sajid hereinafter together called CAHC/AAHL which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context, shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns of the other part.

Now therefore, the parties hereto and hereby mutually agree as follows:

# (1) SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT:

Whereas one of the Principal duties of modern institution of higher education is to enable the students to acquire research experience in latest scientific advances, and this experience valuable element in the preparation of their professional careers.

Whereas an exchange of faculty between the two institution would be fruitful for the participants to exchange their research and their teaching.

Whereas the University should have documentation and regular information on scientific progress of research and training in the fields related to their programmes of academic strength, enter into this agreement and within the limitation of variable funds and policies decision of their governing bodies and executive officers, agree to a program of co-operation which may include any or all of the following:

- Collaborative research between faculty of both institutions in the area of basic sciences including cell and molecular biology. All research activities will be undertaken after getting Institutional Research Board approval from both institutions and will follow all applicable financial and IPR norms of both institutions.
- Participation of teaching faculty of CAHC/AAHL and the University for academic programmes approved by the academic committees of the University and CAHC/AAHL.
- Joint workshops, conferences and seminars on subjects of mutual interest.

## (II) OBLIGATIONS/RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES:

- A. Both sides will maintain ongoing communication and circulate essential information in a timely manner.
- B. Each party acts on its own behalf in all relations with a third party. Neither party will be responsible for any outside commitments of the other party.
- C. The parties shall remain independent of one another and nothing herein shall be construed or interpreted, by implication or otherwise, to form a partnership, agency; joint venture or other formal business association

# (III) NON-DISCRIMINATION:

Two units shall agree that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, nationality, origin, gender, sexual orientation or creed be excluded from participation under the terms of this Agreement.

This MoU shall be personal to the Parties hereto and no Party shall have the right to assign or transfer any right or obligation hereunder in whole or in part to any third party without prior written consent of other Party.





#### **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) entered in to on the 31 st October in the year 2019

#### BETWEEN

Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India, represented by the Prof. Dr. S. THAMARAI SELVI, Vice Chancellor with its headquarters at Vellore, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the ONE PART

AND

National Institute of Unani Medicine (An Autonomous body under the Ministry of Ayush), Government of India, Kottigepalya, Magadi Main Road, Bengaluru – 560091, India represented by its **Director**, **Prof.Abdul Wadud**, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the OTHER PART

Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India, and National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bengaluru, will henceforth be referred to as the 'Parties'. Accordingly, the Parties have decided to enter into this MOU for the aforesaid objectives on the terms & conditions as mentioned hereunder.

#### ARTICLE 1 - OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE

The objective of this MoU is to set out the framework within which NIUM, Bengaluru and Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India, will jointly explore and work towards promoting excellence of economic students' knowledge in their subjects as described in the MoU. Each party shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to determine how it will fulfil its obligations hereunder.

If NIUM Bengaluru and Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India, mutually agree to pursue any of objectives and undertakings herein, the terms and conditions for pursuing such objectives shall be documented on case-to-case basis under project documents to be negotiated and finalized between the parties. The projects may relate to the following subjects:

- Undertake joint studies on Unani management of Chronic disorders like industrial lung and skin diseases and other challenging diseases to the modern world,
- Extending access to library and knowledge sharing facilities mutually for both students and faculty in both the institutions.
- Graduate, Post graduate and Doctoral Research project work and training to be carried out at both TVU and NIUM.
- Organizing and participating in Joint symposia / Conferences/ workshops/ Shortterm Refresher courses conducted by both TVU and NIUM
- Short-term and long-term developmental programs on topics of mutual interest
- To share the expertise in plant based phytocompounds isolation, purification and identification for scientific validation.
- Exchange of faculty for guest lectures between TVU and NIUM
- Extending pre-clinical toxicology and pharmacokinetics /clinical and trial facilities/trials for bio – products developed by TVU and NIUM.
- Designing and conducting of Short term and Long term Unani Diploma / certificate course in Unani Regimenal Therapy and Skin & Cosmetology.
- Identifying thrust area for preparing proposal for getting research funds.
- Identifying international funding agencies, short listing thrust areas of research interest and listing out the format of funding agencies

### **ARTICLE 2 - ADMINISTRATION OF MOU**

To achieve the objective of the NIUM Bengaluru and Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, India. shall set up a Joint Coordination Committee. The JCC may invite any expert to assist its work, if needed

#### **ARTICLE 3 - CONFIDENTIALITY**

Both parties agree that information obtained in carrying out the objectives shall be kept confidential. unless decided otherwise with mutual agreement.

# 1. DISCLOSURE, USE AND RESTRICTIONS:

- 1.1 The Receiving Party shall use the Confidential Information solely in connection with the Purpose identified herein above to explore a potential business relationship between the Parties.
- 1.2 The Receiving Party agrees:
  - (a.) to maintain in confidence all Confidential Information of the Disclosing Party and not use such Confidential Information other than as necessary to carry out the Purpose;
  - (b.) not to disclose any Confidential Information to any person except the Receiving Party's employees, directors, professional advisors and/or independent contractors who have a need to know for the above stated Purpose, and who are bound by obligations of confidentiality no less restrictive than the terms of this Agreement;
  - (c.) to treat all Confidential Information of Discloser with the same degree of care that the Receiving Party accords its own Confidential Information, but in no case less than reasonable care;
  - (d.) to prevent the unauthorized use, dissemination or publication of the Confidential Information;
  - (e.) not to copy or reproduce any or all of the Confidential Information except as is reasonably necessary for the Purpose; and
  - (f.) not to disclose to any person (other than permitted herein) the fact that Confidential Information has been made available, the contents and existence of this Agreement, that negotiations/discussions are taking place or any terms, conditions and status thereof.
- 1.3 The Receiving Party confirms that it has in place reasonable safeguards against the unauthorized disclosure of the Confidential Information such that it can comply with the provisions of this Agreement and agrees that,

Without prejudice to the foregoing, it shall protect the Confidential Information in at least the same manner and to at least the same degree that it protects its own confidential information, but shall in no event, employ less than reasonable degree of care. The Receiving Party further agrees to inform its employees having access to Confidential Information of the obligations hereunder.

1.4 The disclosure of Confidential Information by the Disclosing Party will not create an obligation on either Party to enter into any further agreement or to proceed with any possible relationship or other transaction.

#### **ARTICLE 5 - VALIDITY**

This MOU will come into force upon affixing the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for **Five** years. This MOU may be renewed upon its expiry, with mutual agreement of both the parties.

### **ARTICLE 6 - DISPUTES**

In case any disputes arise in implementing the MoU, these shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation

### **ARTICLE 7 - TERMINATION**

Either party may terminate this MOU with due notice of 6 months and cannot be held liable, in anyway whatsoever, if the objectives cannot be achieved In the event of termination, any information gained from either party by way of technical processes, and procedures in any published or verbal format shall be bound by the confidentiality agreement.

## **ARTICLE 8 - MISCELLANEOUS**

Neither Party shall use or publicize the MoU in such a manner as to cause any disrepute to the other party and shall not make any statement relevant to this MoU which may reasonably be considered to be misleading.
