The International Women's day was celebrated on 8 March 2017 in the Thiruvalluvar university auditorium at 4:00 p.m. the programme began with the lighting of the lamp by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Dr. K. Murugan, The registrar i/c Dr.V. Peruvalluthi, the Controller of examinations Dr. B. Senthilkumar. The theme for the celebration "Women in the changing world of work: Planet 50-50 by 2030 was addressed with serious concern". Women spend double the time than men on household responsibilities. This unequal division of labour is at the expense of women's learning, of paid work, sports, or engagement in civic or community leadership. It was resolved that the university would take initiatives for women students to be exposed to a broad range of career and encouraged t make choices that will lead beyond the traditional service. It was also insisted that women should be ready to be a part of the digital revolution. Measures were taken to remove discrimination that women face on multiple and intersecting fronts over and above their gender: sexual orientation, disability, etc., so as to produce a friendly work environment for women.
