About the University

Thiruvalluvar University was established in Vellore district of Tamil Nadu by the Government of Tamil Nadu in October 2002 under Thiruvalluvar University Act, 2002 (Government of Tamil Nadu Act 32/2002). The University was named after the great Tamil Saint poet "Thiruvalluvar". The University is located in a sprawling campus of about 112.68 acres at Serkkadu, near Vallimalai, about sixteen kms away from the Vellore City on the Ranipet-Chittoor Trunk Road. In the University, every effort is harnessed to make the educational institution as temple of learning. The aim of this University is to provide facilities for advancement in Research and dissemination of knowledge with a special focus on the economic and social upliftment of the marginalized, who live in the four districts viz Vellore, Thiruvannamalai, Ranipet and Thirupattur. These are economically, socially, educationally and geographically backward districts wherein majority of the people live in rural areas with abject poverty. The University provides facilities for research and advancement and dissemination of knowledge with a focus on the economic and social upliftment of oppressed classes.

Role of TVU - Human Resource Development Centre

The aim of the Human Resource Development Centre (HRDC) is to equip the college teachers belonging to different disciplines, with necessary skills to meet the ever-mounting challenges in the field of higher education. The main objective of the HRDC is to cater the needs of the teachers, research scholars and non-academic staff to enhance their knowledge and skills through systematic course work and methodologies. It also aims at providing advanced level capacity enhancement and continuous knowledge upgradation training programs for people working in different capacities and roles and also conducting programs to build research, teaching and administration competence for holistic development of those in the teaching profession.

Objectives of the FDP

Faculty Development Programs (FDP) are tool for fostering knowledge and professional skills in faculty members in order to improve their performance in education, research and administration as well as augmenting organizational capacities and culture. Such programmes not only help the faculty members in augmenting their instructional capabilities in contemporary educational pedagogy but also aids in their professional development with better understanding of professional responsibilities as educators, researchers and administrators as well as in the organizational development with respect to the requirements and main concerns of an institution. FDPs are also useful for career and personal development of a faculty member. They emphasize upon life planning and interpersonal and communication skills of the faculty members. In this regard, Thiruvalluvar University is offering a 3 day Faculty Development Programs (FDP) from 05.12.2022 to 07.12.2022 which aims at deliberation and sharing knowledge to the faculty

members about the significance of innovative teaching methods, research skills and current developments in educational technology, This program will enhance the multilateral thinking approach and will impart capability to look into teaching advanced skill with multi directional approach followed by multidisciplinary research and development work. The purpose of the Faculty Development Programme is to provide an opportunity for teachers working in arts and science colleges affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University to engage with the young faculty members and share their experiences and perspectives relating to newer methods and techniques used in teaching and research with the help of upcoming ICT technologies.

Target Audience

The Faculty Development Program invites faculty from colleges affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University, who are keen to bring innovative changes in their colleges/organization and promote institutional and social responsibilities through their effective teaching skills. Faculty members from different disciplines are eligible as it is an inter-disciplinary programme.

How to Apply

The applicants willing to participate in the programme shall download the application form from Thiruvalluvar University website and submit the filled in application to Dr.P.Vinayagamorthy, University Librarian & Director i/c, Human Resource Development Centre, Thiruvalluvar University, Serkkadu, Vellore -632115 on or before 28th November 2022, 5.30 PM.

Number of Participants

The total number of participants is limited to thirty and will be drawn from various Arts and Science colleges Affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University. Since the number of seats is limited, it will be allotted on a first come first served basis. The participants will be provided with certificates on the successful completion of the programme (FDP).

Resources persons are eminent and accomplished faculty members drawn from reputed universities and institutions within India as well as from the various departments of Thiruvalluvar University.
