COLLEGE SELECTION CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the colleges would be as follows:

1. The colleges signed up for the project will commit to promote entrepreneurship & innovation, including social entrepreneurship in their campuses and allocate required human, financial and physical resources to carry out activities.
2. The institute will encourage all students interested in E&I activities, nurturing E-cell with an added focus on women and other underprivileged classes.
3. The institution shall allocate space for the E&I cell with 100 Mbps speed internet connection for providing e-learning courses to entrepreneurs.
4. Faculty members attached to E-cell allocated part time work would be paid an honorarium of Rs. 5000 per month by the institution allocated.
5. College will be required to apply online. Hubs will also parallel motivate colleges to apply online, at least at the rate 25-35 colleges per hub.
6. College various stage of development in the E&I ladder. Hence their requirements in items input and support would vary. College will be segmented in pre-determined categories on the basis of approach that 'The more potential and commitment to contribute to the outcomes of the scheme, the more service will be offered to institutions'. Segmented is aligned to the goal of creating high performing ventures and jobs, colleges that apply to register under the scheme will be selected based on pre-defined criteria, under the following categories based on the competence and capacity of the college. College divided into three categories based on the current capacity as well as level of outcomes
