About the University

The Thiruvalluvar University was established in Vellore district of Tamil Nadu by the Government of Tamil Nadu in October 2002 under the Thiruvalluvar University Act, 2002. The University was named after the great Tamil Saint poet "Thiruvalluvar". The University is located in a sprawling campus of about 112.68 acres at the Serkkadu near Vallimalai about sixteen km away from the Vellore City on the Ranipet-Chittoor Trunk Road.

In the University, every effort is harnessed to make Educational Institution as temple of learning. The aim of this University is to provide facilities for advancement in Research and dissemination of knowledge with a special focus on the economic and social upliftment of the marginalised who live in the four districts a viz Vellore, Thiruvannamalai, Villupuram and Cuddalore which are economically, socially, educationally and geographically backward districts wherein majority of the people live in rural areas with abject poverty. Especially the Vellore district comprises a thick population of Adivasis and Scheduled Tribes who are yet to attain empowerment in higher education. The University to provide for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge with a focus on the economic and social upliftment of oppressed classes including Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Most Backward Classes, Denotified Communities, and Backward Classes. About the Department

The Department of Economics was one of the first departments to be established at Vellore during the time of the erstwhile Autonomous Post Graduate Centre of the University of Madras more than two decades ago, and it was annexed to Thiruvalluvar University in 1992 when the Autonomous Centre evolved into Thiruvalluvar University act 2002. The department has a sufficient number of Computers with wifi access for effective teaching and research. GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT AND FULL PAPER

The abstract (500 words) and full paper (10 to 12 Pages) should be submitted by email to - **ncicssr23@gmail.com**. An expert committee will short-list the selected papers. Selected full papers will be double blind refereed by the peer experts for their selection for publication in the edited volume/Referred Journal (with ISBN/ISSN).

The papers should be submitted in both hard and soft copy (in MS word, Times New Roman, A-4 size with one-and-a-half line spacing and one-inch margin all around and maximum 10 to 12 pages). Papers without soft copy will not be accepted. The research papers shall be preferably in the standard research format, spelling out the need for the study, objectives of the study, hypothesis if any, methodology, techniques of data analysis, findings/ results, conclusion, references and statistical tables, in that order.

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

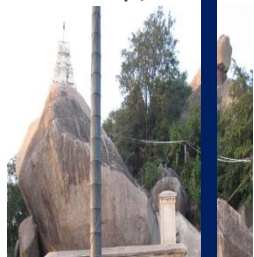
Thirupardakal is a small district near Vellore which boasts of being home to the most unique and rare temples of Hinduism. The presiding deity is Lord Thirumal- a manifestation of Lord Vishnu, who stands on top of Lord Shiva to assert that Vaishnavism and Saivism are one and the same.

A temple dedicated to Shiva lies in the Mahadeva Malai Hills in Kankuppam village, Vellore district, Tamil Nadu. The temple lies to the west of Katpadi. It is situated on the hill-top, which is of a single stone. The temple is called Mahadeva Malai Temple, which was built by a trader of the Pandya kingdom. The temple is believed to be five hundred years old. The consort of Shiva in this temple is Goddess Kamakshi.

Vallimalai is a dear place to Valli and thus Valli, Murugan and Deyvaanai live eternally at this place. There is the Thiruppugazh aashramam atop Vallimalai,

where the tradition of Valli lives on. During the Pallava dynasty's regime, they built the Subramaniyar temple, a rock cut temple dedicated to Murugan. The temple is one of the monuments of national importance in Tamil Nadu.

The Ratnagiri Temple is dedicated to Lord Murugan. It was renovated in the year 1980 by Bala Muruganadimai Swamy. The temple boasts a huge tower at the entrance. One of the special features of this temple is that the poojas are conducted in Tamil instead of common Sanskrit. According to the locals, the divine power in the temple manifests its blessings in three forms
